| 201 Santa Margherita, Pinot Grigio Trentino, Italy
<i>The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make this pinot grigio perfect as an apéritif or great with seafood salads and fish or with white meat.</i> | 43. |
| 202 Bertani, "Due Uve" Sauvignon Blanc/Pinot Grigio Veneto, Italy
<i>Light and crisp while having a creamy texture and underlying richness. Vernaccia is a terrific wine with unique flavors and complexity that is unfortunately often overlooked.</i> | 26. |
| 203 Angeline, Chardonnay Russian River Valley, California
<i>Lush aromas of lemon, ripe cantaloupe and kiwi that transitions to flavors of honeydew, citrus, and green apple. The creamy mouthfeel make it perfect with cream sauce based pasta dishes and medium to heavy fare.</i> | 28. |
| 204 Frog's Leap, Chardonnay Napa, California
<i>Aromas of wet stone and white peaches with notes of honeysuckle. Flavors of grapefruit and lemongrass lead to a mouthfeel that touches on layers of toasted coconut. Refreshingly crisp with a tart acidity.</i> | 39. |
| 302 Andrew Rich, "Cuvée B" Pinot Noir Willamette Valley, Oregon
<i>This wine has a beautiful, dark color with aromas of mixed berries, earth, smoke, and violets. It is very succulent with nice acidity on the finish, making it great with a variety of dishes from grilled seafood to duck and veal.</i> | 35. |
| 303 Giacossa Fratelli, Barbera d'Alba Piedmont, Italy
<i>The perfect alternative to Pinot Noir! This 100% Barbera has an intense and fruity nose. Shows nice cherry fruits with a long, dry finish. Perfect for roasted or grilled meats, hearty soups, or heavy pasta dishes.</i> | 28. |
| 304 Il Palagetto, Chianti Colli Senesi Italy
<i>Ruby red with nice cherry fruit on the nose and a hint of earth. A nice alternative to pinot noir with a dry finish. Goes well with a variety of dishes including antipasto, pastas, fish, light to medium soups, or excellent by itself.</i> | 28. |
| 305 Quattro Mani, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Abruzzi, Italy
<i>100% Montepulciano with aromas of dark fruit and earth. The dark fruits are perfectly balanced with the oak used in the wine. This wine is a perfect accompaniment with roasted meats, rich pastas, and seasoned cheeses.</i> | 27. |
| 306 Campogiovanni, Rosso di Montalcino Tuscany, Italy
<i>This baby Brunello shows loads of ripe cherry, soft tannins and a rich, spicy body. It's perfect with heartier pasta dishes.</i> | 36. |
| 307 San Felice, Chianti Classico Riserva Tuscany, Italy
<i>A deep, ruby red, this releases lingering, complex fragrances redolent of sweet violets and wild red, berry fruit. Succulent tannins complement a delicate fruitiness, as does a broad complex of aromas enriched by just a hint of toasty oak.</i> | 37. |
| 308 Napa Cellars, Merlot Napa, California
<i>Aromas of boysenberry cobbler, black cherry, delicate wild strawberries and vanilla coffee bean intrigue the senses, leaving your mouth watering for the flavors that come of red reaspberry, plum, nutmeg and lavender.</i> | 34. |
| 309 The Wishing Tree, Shiraz Western Australia
<i>Lashings of dark chocolate on the nose. Showing the classic richness of Barossa Shiraz with a superb depth of fruit on the middle palate reined in by fine chalky tannins on the finish.</i> | 25. |
| 310 Crios de Susana Balbo, Malbec Mendoza, Argentina
<i>A great alternative to cabernet or merlot, this is a deep purple color with aromas of crushed cherries and smoky oak. The flavors of cherries are jammy with hints of spice. Enjoy with grilled or roasted meats or pastas.</i> | 25. |
| 311 Josh Cellars, Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma, California
<i>Selected from some of the top wineries in Sonoma. It is a big bold red with aromas of dark fruits, vanilla, and leather. Full-bodied with ripe tannins and a long finish. It's a perfect match with steak, roasted meats and pasta dishes.</i> | 30. |
| 312 Joel Gott, Zinfandel Lodi, California
<i>Brilliant ruby color, nose of strawberries, raspberries and vanilla with a juicy, spicy palate. The old vines produce intensity and structure while packing it full of flavors.</i> | 29. |
| 401 Turnbull, Cabernet Sauvignon Napa, California
<i>Ripe and fleshy, with generous plum, black cherry and red cherry fruit that is intense and complex without being too powerful. The wine ends with firm balanced tannins and is a perfect accompaniment with steaks and heavy dishes.</i> | 75. |
